IMPACT OF THE TOWERS RATE INCREASE ON THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

- Main impact on DOT is under item #5, Schedule A Rates and
- the CPI as well as compared with other jurisdictions Tower Fee increase requests were researched and adjusted against
- CPI increases for September 2005 to 2008 was 25.64
- Overall average fee increase per tow is 22.8%
- \$5 effective November 2006 per tow as follows: Last rate increase in November 2005 with an additional increase of
- 1. Charles Street and East from \$85 to \$100 + \$5 = \$105
- 2. West of Charles Street from \$95 to \$110 + \$5 =
- 3. South Hanover Street from \$95 to \$110 + \$5 = \$115

IMPACT OF THE TOWERS RATE INCREASE ON THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

- Current Rate Increase is applicable to two zones
- Covers expanded zone areas instead of three as earlier
- To meet the rising fuel, utility and operational costs
- Zone 1 from \$105 per tow to \$130
- Zone 2 from \$115 per tow to \$140
- This rate increase is collected from the property owners
- Impact on DOT's Budget is Zero
- This rate increase is not used to offset a budget shortfall

DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IMPACT OF THE TOWERS RATE INCREASE ON THE

- Increased rates in November 2005/2006 did not have an impact or rise in number of unclaimed vehicles
- Number of vehicles in the tow lot from November 2005 to current are shown below:
- November 1, 2005 2,562
- November 1, 2006 2,560
- May 1, 2009 1
- Negotiated with the towers to change monthly invoicing to weekly invoicing for better work distribution
