2 FOR the purpose of designating the St. Peter the Apostle Church Complex, 13 South Poppleton
3 Street, 11 South Poppleton Street, 848 Hollins Street, and 16 South Poppleton Street, as a
4 historical landmark.

7 Section(s) 13-1, to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 13. Landmark List - 2010s”

10 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the
11 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

15 **§ 13-1. ST. PETER THE APOSTLE CHURCH COMPLEX.**

16 ST. PETER THE APOSTLE CHURCH COMPLEX, 13 SOUTH POPPLETON STREET, 11 SOUTH
17 POPPLETON STREET, 848 HOLLINS STREET, AND 16 SOUTH POPPLETON STREET.

18 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
19 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
20 Ordinance.
