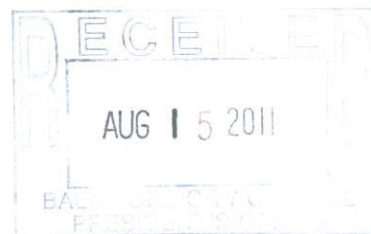
RE: Bill No. 11-0732 Baltimore City Landmark List: Grand Masonic Temple
