AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

1 **Supplementary Municipal Telephone Exchange Fund Operating Appropriation –**
2 **Municipal Telephone Exchange (Service 133 - Telecommunications) – \$1,400,000**

3 FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary Municipal Telephone Exchange Fund Operating
4 Appropriation in the amount of \$1,400,000 to the Municipal Telephone Exchange (Service
5 133 - Telecommunications), to provide funding for a series of one-time improvements to help
6 upgrade the City's Call Center, support ongoing telework technology, increase wireless
7 phone security, and support upgrades at the Courthouse and Pratt Library; and providing for a
8 special effective date.

14 **Recitals**

15 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a Municipal Telephone Exchange
16 fund balance in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax
17 levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2026.

18 This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
19 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2026 was formulated.

20 The municipal agency responsible for the production of this additional revenue is the Office
21 of the Comptroller.

22 On September 17, 2025, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
23 Council.

1 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That
2 \$1,400,000 shall be made available to the Municipal Telephone Exchange
3 (Service 133 - Telecommunications) as a Municipal Telephone Exchange Fund Operating
4 Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2026, to provide funding for a series of one-time improvements to
5 help upgrade the City's Call Center, support ongoing telework technology, increase wireless
6 phone security, and support upgrades at the Courthouse and Pratt Library. The source of revenue
7 for this appropriation is a Municipal Telephone Exchange fund balance in excess of the amount
8 from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required
9 to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2026.

10 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
11 enacted.
