

RE: City Council Bill 14-0331



I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 14-0331 introduced by Council President Bernard Jack Young at the request of The Administration (Department of General Services).

The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in a certain parcel of land known as the former beds of certain streets and alleys bounded by East 21<sup>st</sup> Street, Greenmount Avenue, East 20<sup>th</sup> Street, and Barclay Street (Ward 12, Section 12, Block 3805) and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority reviewed the location in the evening on April 23, 2014 and believes that the direct sale of this property will have no negative effect on parking in the area. The Parking Authority is aware of the overall development plans for this area and will be readily available to any City agencies, elected officials, and community groups for discussions regarding parking.

Based on the above comments, the Baltimore City Parking Authority supports the passage of City Council Bill 14-0331.
