You have requested the advice of the Law Department regarding City Council Bill 08-0087. City Council Bill 87 amends Article 1, Section 23-4 of the Baltimore City Code by modifying the qualifications required to serve as a member of the Commission on Disabilities, modifying the agencies represented on the Commission as non-voting associates and modifyings the residency requirements for certain members.
