The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 19-0148R for form and legal sufficiency. This resolution is for the purpose of inviting the Commissioner of Housing and Community development, the Executive Director of the Housing Authority of Baltimore City, the Health Commissioner, and the Secretary of the Maryland Department of Health or his designee to appear before the City council to discuss the potential dangers of mold in housing.
