1 As Baltimore emerges as a major player in the bio-tech, business, tourism, medical, and  
2 education arenas, adding this on-demand car company could only serve to enhance the  
3 attractiveness of our city to an increasingly progressive and savvy clientele.

4 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That  
5 representatives of the Zipcar company are cordially invited to address the City Council on the  
6 feasibility of providing this innovative web-based car-sharing service to citizens and workers in  
7 Baltimore City, to determine the logistics of providing this service within the City's  
8 infrastructure, and the Directors of the Department of Planning and the Department of  
9 Transportation are requested to study the issue and submit recommendations to the Council  
10 within 6 months of the date of the hearing.

11 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That a copy of this Resolution be sent to the Mayor, the  
12 President and Vice-President of Marketing, Zipcar Co., the Director of the Department of  
13 Planning, the Director of the Department of Transportation, and the Mayor's Legislative Liaison  
14 to the City Council.
