INTRODUCTION - Rezoning - 2529 Georgetown Road

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> - For the purpose of changing the zoning for the property known as 2529 Georgetown Road (Block 7796, Lot 003), as outlined in red on the accompanying plat, from the R-6 Zoning District to the I-1 Zoning District.
