11 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the  
12 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

14 Article 28. Taxes

15 Subtitle 10. Credits

16 § 10-8. Historic improvements, restorations, and rehabilitations.

17 (k) *Administration.*

18 The Finance Director ~~AND~~, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE DIRECTOR OF PLANNING,  
19 may:

20 (1) adopt rules and regulations to carry out this section;

1 (2) settle any disputed claims that may arise in connection with the credit authorized  
2 by this section; and

3 (3) delegate his or her powers and duties to administer this section to any employee or  
4 agency of the City.

5 (m) *Termination of program.*

6 Applications for a credit under this section may not be accepted after February 28, [2021]  
7 2022.

8 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance  
9 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior  
10 Ordinance.

11 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is  
12 enacted.




