2 3 4	The Curtis Bay Energy Limited Partnership operates a medical waste incinerator in Hawkins Point, Baltimore City. The City recognizes the importance of safe and efficient waste disposal facilities.

5 6	This Ordinance is necessary to enhance the cogeneration capacity and capabilities of the waste-to-energy facility and is otherwise in the public interest.
