Re: City Council Bill 08-0010– Baltimore City Landmark List – Upton Mansion

The Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 08-0010, which was introduced for the purpose of designating the Upton Mansion, 811 West Lanvale Street, as a historical landmark.

The Upton Mansion is a stately, three-story Greek Revival house dating to 1839. The building once served as home of one of Baltimore's first radio stations. Since 1977, the house has been headquarters for the Baltimore City Public School System's Home and Hospital Services.

With these items discussed and resolved, the Department of Housing and Community Development supports adoption of City Council Bill 08-0010.
