This CCB 15-0555 Coal Tar Products – Prohibition on Use or Sale is for the purpose of prohibiting the use or sale in the City of Baltimore of coal tar pavement products and provides a fine for violation of this prohibition.

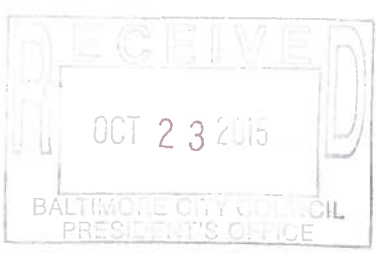
**Analysis**

This legislation prohibits the use or sale of coal tar pavement products, provides for the administration and enforcement of this prohibition by the Building Official, requires the Building Official to publish a list of alternative pavement products, and provides for a penalty of \$1,000 per day for violations of the prohibition, specifying that each day a violation continues is a separate fineable offense.

**Fiscal Impact**

The Department of Finance defers to the Department of Housing and Community Development with respect to the fiscal impact of the administration of this legislation and estimates that any revenue resulting from the fines contained therein will be minimal and will not have a significant effect on overall City revenues.
