The proposed legislation would provide for the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a pharmacy: Drive-in on the property known as 1301 Baylis Street (a/k/a 3500 Boston Street), as outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

The Fire Department does not object to City Council Bill # 08-0230 provided that all applicable sections of the Fire and Building Codes are adhered. This may include a requirement for plans to be submitted to the Fire Department, an annual Fire Inspection, permit, automatic sprinkler system, and Fire Alarm system.
