BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the 11 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows: 12 **Baltimore City Code** 13 **Article 19. Police Ordinances** 14 Subtitle 18. Drugs – Salvia Divinorum 15 §18-1. DEFINITIONS. 16 17 (A) IN GENERAL. IN THIS SUBTITLE, THE FOLLOWING TERMS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED. 18 (B) SALVIA DIVINORUM. 19 (1) GENERAL. 20 "Salvia divinorum" means the plant classified botanically as Salvia 21

8	(V) ANY COUNTERFEIT OR SIMULATED FORM OF ANY OF THESE.

10	(A) SALE, GIVE, ETC.
11	NO PERSON MAY:
12 13	(1) SELL, GIVE, OR OTHERWISE TRANSFER SALVIA DIVINORUM TO ANOTHER PERSON; OR
14 15	(2) POSSESS FOR THE PURPOSE OR WITH THE INTENT OF SELLING, GIVING, OR OTHERWISE TRANSFERRING SALVIA DIVINORUM TO ANOTHER PERSON.
16	(B) GROW, MANUFACTURE, ETC.
17 18	No person may plant, cultivate, grow, harvest, or manufacture or compound any Salvia divinorum.
19	(C) Possession, use, etc.
20 21	No person may possess, chew, smoke, or otherwise ingest or use any Salvia divinorum.

23	§18-4. PENALTIES.
24	(A) VIOLATION A MISDEMEANOR.
25 26	Any person who violates any provision of this subtitle is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, is subject to the following penalties.
27	(B) SALE, GIVE, ETC.
28 29	For a violation of § 18-2(a) {Prohibited conduct: Sale, give, etc."}, the penalty is a fine of up to $1,000$ or imprisonment for up to 1 year or both.

- (C) GROW, MANUFACTURE, ETC. 1 For a violation of § 18-2(b) {Prohibited conduct: Grow, manufacture, etc."}, 2 THE PENALTY IS A FINE OF UP TO \$500 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR UP TO 6 MONTHS OR BOTH. 3 4 (D) POSSESS, USE, ETC. For a violation of § 18-2(c) {Prohibited conduct: Possess, use, etc."}, the 5 PENALTY IS A FINE OF UP TO \$500 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR UP TO 6 MONTHS OR BOTH. 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance 7 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior 8 Ordinance. 9
- 10 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th 11 day after the date it is enacted.
