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A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Gun Offender Registration – Update of Residence**

3 FOR the purpose of clarifying and expanding the circumstances under which certain registered  
4 gun offenders are required to update their residence and other registration information; and  
5 generally relating to the maintenance and enforcement of the gun offender registry.

6 BY repealing and reordaining, without amendments

16 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
17 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

18 **Baltimore City Code**

19 **Article 19. Police Ordinances**

20 **Subtitle 60. Gun Offender Registration**

21 **§ 60-6. Verification by resident offenders.**

22 (a) *Scope.*

23 This section applies only to gun offenders who are residents of Baltimore City.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate matter added to existing law.  
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

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1 (c) *Update on CHANGE OF residence [address].*

2 [Within 10 calendar days after establishing or changing a residence within the City of  
3 Baltimore, a] A gun offender must personally appear at an office designated by the Police  
4 Commissioner to update HIS OR HER RESIDENCE ADDRESS [the] AND OTHER contents of the  
5 registration:

6 (1) WITHIN 10 CALENDAR DAYS AFTER ESTABLISHING A RESIDENCE IN BALTIMORE  
7 CITY;

8 (2) WITHIN 10 CALENDAR DAYS AFTER MOVING FROM ONE RESIDENCE IN BALTIMORE  
9 CITY TO ANOTHER RESIDENCE IN BALTIMORE CITY; AND

10 (3) BEFORE MOVING FROM A RESIDENCE IN BALTIMORE CITY AND ASSUMING A NEW  
11 RESIDENCE OUT OF BALTIMORE CITY.

12 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance  
13 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior  
14 Ordinance.

15 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
16 after the date it is enacted.
