2	[Within 10 calendar days after establishing or changing a residence within the City of
3	Baltimore, a] A gun offender must personally appear at an office designated by the Police
4	Commissioner to update HIS OR HER RESIDENCE ADDRESS [the] AND OTHER contents of the
5	registration:
6	(1) WITHIN 10 CALENDAR DAYS AFTER ESTABLISHING A RESIDENCE IN BALTIMORE
7	City;
8	(2) WITHIN 10 CALENDAR DAYS AFTER MOVING FROM ONE RESIDENCE IN BALTIMORE
9	CITY TO ANOTHER RESIDENCE IN BALTIMORE CITY; AND
10	(3) BEFORE MOVING FROM A RESIDENCE IN BALTIMORE CITY AND ASSUMING A NEW
11	RESIDENCE OUT OF BALTIMORE CITY.
12	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
13	are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
14	Ordinance.
15	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30 th day
16	after the date it is enacted.
