City Council Bill No. 12-0101 has been referred by your Honorable Body to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals for study and report.

The purpose of City Council Bill No. 12-0101 is to require licenses for private kennels; establishing the procedures for issuing or revoking private kennel licenses; making the failure to obtain private kennel license punishable by citation; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the licensing of private kennels.

The BMZA has reviewed the legislation and has no objection to the passage of Bill 12-0101.

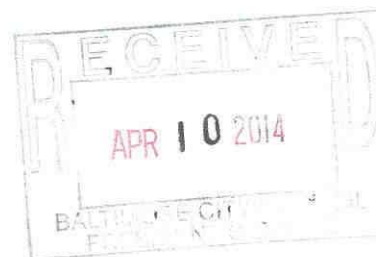
