5 the Waverly Merchants Association; and generally relating to the Board of Directors for the
6 Charles Village Community Benefits District.

12 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
13 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

14 **Baltimore City Code**

15 **Article 14. Special Benefits Districts**

16 **Subtitle 6. Charles Village Community Benefits District**

17 **§ 6-6. Board of Directors.**

18 (e) *Minimum representation.*

19 The following minimum representation shall be present on the full Board, except during
20 periods of temporary vacancies:

21 (4) At least 6 voting Board members shall be from the following constituent
22 organizations within the District:

23 (i) the [Better Greenmount Alliance] WAVERLY MERCHANTS ASSOCIATION,

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1 (ii) the Old Goucher Business Alliance, Inc., and

2 (iii) the North Charles Village Business Association.

3 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
4 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
5 Ordinance.

6 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
7 after the date it is enacted.
