City Council Bill #11-0650 has been introduced for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in a certain properties that are known as 601-603, 621, 701, 709, 750, 801, and 810 McCabe Avenue and are no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

The subject properties are vacant and abandoned residential properties located in the Winston-Govans neighborhood. The neighborhood has been working with the Department of Housing and Community Development to redevelop these properties. If approved, this bill will allow the City to sell the subject properties to Chesapeake Habitat for Humanity for rehabilitation through the organization's sweat-equity home rehabilitation program.
