City Council Bill No. 08-250-Street Regulations-Obstructions

The Baltimore Police Department (BPD) has reviewed City Council Bill No. 08-0250-Street Regulations-Obstructions which is introduced for the purpose of consolidating certain provisions governing the obstructions of streets, lanes, sidewalks, footways, or alleys. The bill also repeals obsolete or unnecessary provisions of Article 19-Police Ordinances.

Council Bill No. 08-0250 clarifies prohibited rights of way and provides for an exception for someone in the immediate act of delivering or removing items from a place of business or a dwelling. The BPD supports these changes. Thank you for the opportunity to comment on this legislation.
