A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Transit and Traffic – Obstructing or Impeding Traffic**

3 FOR the purpose of modifying the fine imposed for obstructing or impeding the free flow of  
4 traffic; and generally relating to the regulation of traffic and the parking, standing, and  
5 stopping of vehicles.

6 BY repealing and reordaining

7 Article 31 - Transit and Traffic

11 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
12 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

13 **Baltimore City Code**

14 **Article 31. Transit and Traffic**

15 **Subtitle 36. Parking, etc., Fines, Penalties, and Procedures**

16 **§ 36-4. \$250 fines.**

17 [(1)] Parking or standing a noncommercial vehicle of more than 20,000 pounds gross  
18 weight or a commercial vehicle of 20,000 pounds or less gross vehicle weight in violation  
19 of § 6-26(b) {“Stopping by residence”} of this article is punishable by a fine of \$250.

20 [(2) Obstructing or impeding the free flow of traffic is punishable by a fine of \$250.]

21 **§ 36-5. \$100 fines.**

22 (1) Parking, stopping, or standing in violation of posted restrictions for the Pimlico Race  
23 Track Area is punishable by a fine of \$100.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate matter added to existing law.  
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

**Council Bill 10-0604**

1 (2) Parking, stopping, or standing in violation of posted restrictions in any Residential Permit  
2 Parking Program Area within the Camden Yards Stadium Complex Area, at any time  
3 between 1 hour before the advertised start of a stadium event and 1 hour after the event  
4 ends, is punishable by a fine of \$100.

5 (3) OBSTRUCTING OR IMPEDING THE FREE FLOW OF TRAFFIC IS PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF  
6 \$100.

7 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance  
8 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior  
9 Ordinance.

10 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
11 after the date it is enacted.
