Re: City Council Bill 19-0363: City Streets – Closing – A Variable Width Alley, Located Between 2 10-Foot Alleys Bounded by Boone Street, East 22nd Street, Greenmount Avenue, and East 23rd Street

The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 19-0363, for the purpose of condemning and closing a variable width alley, located between 2 10-foot alleys bounded by Boone Street, East 22nd Street, Greenmount Avenue, and East 23rd Street, as shown on Plat 284-A-15A in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

If enacted, this bill, along with the accompanying opening and sale bills, will enable Mother Seton Academy to move forward with plans to construct a gymnasium on this block.
