**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

**City Streets – Opening –  
Eutaw Street**

3 FOR the purpose of condemning and opening Eutaw Street, extending from Pratt Street southerly  
4 to Camden Street, as shown on Plat 347-A-69 in the Office of the Department of Public  
5 Works; and providing for a special effective date.

14 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
15 Department of Public Works shall proceed to condemn and open Eutaw Street, extending from  
16 Pratt Street southerly to Camden Street, and more particularly described as follows:

17 Beginning for Parcel No.1 at the point formed by the intersection of the south side  
18 of Pratt Street, 56 feet wide and the west side of Eutaw Street, 84 feet wide, and  
19 running thence binding on the south side of said Pratt Street, Easterly, 84.0 feet to  
20 intersect the east side of said Eutaw Street; thence binding on the east side of said  
21 Eutaw Street, Southerly 323.3 feet, more or less, to intersect the north side of  
22 Camden Street, 61 feet wide; thence binding on north side of said Camden Street,  
23 Westerly 84.0 feet to intersect the west side of said Eutaw Street, and thence  
24 binding on the west side of said Eutaw Street, Northerly 323.6 feet, more or less,  
25 to the place of beginning.

**EXPLANATION:** CAPITALS indicate matter added to existing law.  
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.  
Underlining indicates matter added to the bill by amendment.  
~~Strike out~~ indicates matter stricken from the bill by  
amendment or deleted from existing law by amendment.

3 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the proceedings for the condemnation and  
4 opening of Eutaw Street and the rights of all interested parties shall be regulated by and in  
5 accordance with all applicable provisions of state and local law and with all applicable rules and  
6 regulations adopted by the Director of Public Works and filed with the Department of  
7 Legislative Reference.

8 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it  
9 is enacted.
