

I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 11-0684 introduced by Council Members Clarke, Curran, and Henry.

The purpose of the Bill is to amend the Urban Renewal Plan for Waverly Business Area, to amend and clarify certain land uses and to correct, clarify and conform certain language; waive certain content and procedural requirements; make the provisions of this Ordinance severable; and provide for the application of this Ordinance with certain other ordinances.

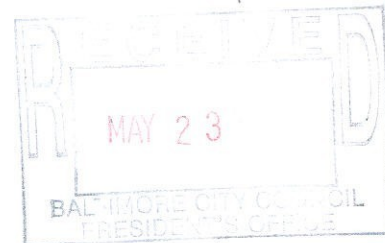
Ordinance 79-1029 established the Urban Renewal Plan for Waverly Business Area and was last amended by Ordinance 02-371. The Waverly Business Area is centered along Greenmount Avenue, between East 29th Street and East 35th Street and along eastern portions of East 33rd Street and Old York Road. City Council Bill 11-0684, if approved, would amend the Community Business portion of the Land Use Provisions and Standards section of the Urban Renewal Plan to prohibit bail bond agencies in these districts.

The Department of Public Works has no objection to the passage of City Council Bill 11-0684.
