Major Issues Discussed

- 1. Noise pollution caused by gas-powered leaf blowers, which can lead to hearing damage, stress-related illnesses, high blood pressure, speech interference, and sleep disruption.
- 2. Air pollution from gas-powered leaf blowers, including the emission of particulate matter, carbon monoxide, and volatile organic compounds like benzene, a known carcinogen.
- 3. Transition to electric and battery-operated leaf blowers, which are quieter, less polluting, and increasingly cost-effective.
- 4. The impact on small businesses and the need for a transition period to allow businesses to adapt to new regulations without undue financial strain.
