4 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
5 Council invites representatives from the Department of General Services, the Mayor’s Office of
6 Information Technology, the Maryland Energy Administration, the Maryland Public Service
7 Commission, and the Office of the Maryland People’s Counsel to appear before the Council to
8 discuss the feasibility of developing a “Baltimore City Electric Choice Website” and the
9 formation of a work group to consider the further development of mechanisms to advance true
10 competition in Baltimore City’s residential and small commercial mass electricity market.

11 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That a copy of this Resolution be sent to the Mayor, the
12 Director of General Services, the Chief Information Officer in the Mayor’s Office of Information
13 Technology, the Director of the Maryland Energy Administration, the Director of the Maryland
14 Public Service Commission, the Maryland People’s Counsel, and the Mayor’s Legislative
15 Liaison to the City Council.
