A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Supplementary Federal Fund Operating Appropriation –**  
3 **Baltimore City Police Department – \$1,600,500**

4 FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary Federal Fund Operating Appropriation in the  
5 amount of \$1,600,500 to the Baltimore City Police Department – Program 201 (Field  
6 Operations), to provide funding for planning, equipment, training, exercises, management  
7 and administration of protective actions aimed to enhance the ability of State and local  
8 agencies to prevent, respond to, recover from incidents of terrorism, and reduce the  
9 vulnerabilities around identified critical infrastructure and key resource locations/sites; and  
10 providing for a special effective date.

16 **Recitals**

17 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the Maryland  
18 Emergency Management Agency (MEMA), U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Office of  
19 Domestic Preparedness in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in  
20 determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2006.

21 That grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of  
22 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2006 was formulated.

23 On November 2, 2005, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City  
24 Council.

25 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That**  
26 **\$1,600,500 shall be made available to the Baltimore City Police Department – Program 201**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate matter added to existing law.  
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

1 (Field Operations) as a Supplementary Federal Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year  
2 2006, to provide funding for planning, equipment, training, exercises, management and  
3 administration to enhance the ability of State and local agencies to prevent, respond to, and  
4 recover from incidents of terrorism. The source of revenue for this appropriation is a grant from  
5 the Maryland Emergency Management Agency in excess of the amount from this source that  
6 was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the  
7 budget for Fiscal Year 2006.

8 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it  
9 is enacted.
