15	Recitals
16	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents \$400,000 in excess of the revenue
17	relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for
18	Fiscal Year 2023.
19	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
20	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2023 was formulated.
21	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
22	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2023 was formulated or is for a new program that could
23	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
24	On November 15, 2023, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
25	Council.

## Council Bill 23-0463

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
\$400,000 shall be made available to the MR: Office of Children and Family Success –
Service 109 (Administration-Children and Family Success) as a Supplementary General Fund
Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2023, to provide funding for balancing the MR: Office
of Children and Family Success budget for Fiscal Year 2023 due to costs associated with
unplanned contractual staffing costs that were not fully offset by vacancy savings. The source of
revenue for this appropriation is generated from the transfer tax in excess of the amount from this
source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to
balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2023.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
