SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That 22 \$190,500 shall be made available to the Department of General Services (Account # 9916-23 909015-9194) as a Supplementary Federal Fund Grant Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2011, to 24 provide funding to underwrite a collaborative effort between the Department of General Services 25 and the Johns Hopkins University Office of Sustainability to promote energy conservation by 26
