1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **General Fund Appropriation Transfer –**
3 **M-R: Debt Service (Service 123 - General Debt Service) to**
4 **the Police Department (Service 622 - Police Patrol) – \$9,000,000**

5 FOR the purpose of transferring a General Fund Appropriation in the amount of \$9,000,000 from
6 M-R: Debt Service (Service 123 - General Debt Service) to the Police Department (Service
7 622 - Police Patrol); and providing for a special effective date.

13 **Recitals**

14 Article VI, § 9(a)(2) of the City Charter provides that, on recommendation of the Board of
15 Estimates, the City Council by ordinance may authorize the transfer of an appropriation
16 contained in the Ordinance of Estimates from one municipal agency to another municipal agency.

17 The sum of \$9,000,000, as appropriated to the M-R: Debt Service (Service 123 - General
18 Debt Service) in the Fiscal 2017 Ordinance of Estimates, is not needed for the purpose for which
19 it was appropriated and, therefore, is available for transfer to another agency.

20 On June 14, 2017, the Board of Estimates recommended the transfer authorized by this
21 Ordinance.

22 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
23 sum of \$9,000,000, contained in the Fiscal 2017 Ordinance of Estimates as a General Fund
24 Appropriation, is transferred from M-R: Debt Service (Service 123 - General Debt Service) to the
25 Police Department (Service 622 - Police Patrol).
