Re: **City Council Bill 13-0178 – City Streets – Closing – City Streets – Closing – All Streets and Alleys Bounded by North Avenue, Warwick Avenue, Baker Street, and the CSX Transportation, Inc. Railroad Right of Way**

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 13-0178, which was introduced for the purpose of condemning and closing all streets and alleys bounded by North Avenue, Warwick Avenue, Baker Street, and the CSX Transportation, Inc. Railroad Right of Way, as shown on Plat 298-A-16A in the Office of the Department of General Services; and providing for a special effective date.

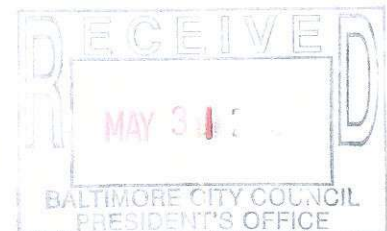
This bill, if adopted, would condemn and close all city-owned streets bounded by North Avenue, Warwick Avenue, Baker Street, and the CSX Transportation, Inc. Railroad Right of Way. These parcels are located in the Coppin State University area of the city and this legislation will help facilitate the construction of a new Science and Technology Center.

City Council Bill 13-0178, along with its companion legislation, City Council Bill 13-0177 and City Council Bill 13-0179, which would open certain city streets and authorize their sale, respectively, will allow for the entire site to be redeveloped as the new Science and Technology Center.

The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection to the adoption of City Council Bill 13-0178.
