3	FOR the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and
4 5	operation of a parking, open off-street area on the property known as 6308 Belair Road, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
12	permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a parking, open off-
13	street area on the property known as 6308 Belair Road, as outlined in red on the plat
14	accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 6-309(1) and
15	14-102, subject to the condition that the following conditions:
16	1. The parking, open off-street area will be used for employee parking, and it may not be
17	used for the storage of towed vehicles or vehicles awaiting repairs.
18	2. The parking, open off-street area must be developed according to the site plan
19	provided by the Department of Planning, dated September 27, 2013.
20	3. The site plan provided by the Department of Planning is attached to and made part of
21	this Ordinance.
22	4. The parking, open off-street area complies must comply with all applicable federal,
23	state, and local licensing and certification requirements.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and the Zoning Administrator.
9	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30 th day
