The purpose of this legislation is to designate W.E.B. Du Bois House, 2302 Montebello Terrace, as a historical landmark.

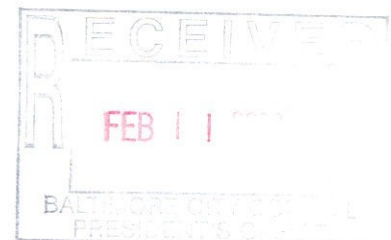
