Major Issues Discussed

- 1. Councilwoman Phylicia Porter discusses the challenges posed by the overturn of Roe v. Wade and the subsequent efforts by anti-choice legislators across the nation. The bill aims to address these challenges by ensuring reproductive health protections in Baltimore.
- 2. Julia Roche from the Baltimore City Health Department outlines recent state laws in Maryland that bolster protections for individuals seeking abortion care, including restrictions on sharing clinical information outside the state.
- 3. Ebony Thompson from the City Solicitor's Office provides historical context on abortion laws in the United States, emphasizing the recent overturn of the Dobbs decision and the resulting increase in state legislative activities on both sides of the abortion issue.
- 4. Concerns about data breaches and the protection of electronic medical records are raised, with a focus on how the city plans to monitor the storage and distribution of clinical or personal information from individuals seeking reproductive care.
- 5. Questions are raised about collaboration with law enforcement entities, such as the sheriff's department, MTA police, and other public safety agencies, to ensure adherence to laws and mitigate potential risks related to human trafficking.
