Re: **City Council Bill 09-0296 City Streets - Closing – Oakhill Avenue**

The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 09-0296, which was introduced for the purpose of condemning and closing Oakhill Avenue, extending from 20th Street, Northerly 90.0 feet, more or less, to the south side of a 15-foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties known as 800 through 928 East 20th Street, as shown on Plat 190-A-27 in the Office of the Department of Public Works.

The closing of this street will facilitate the Blazing Star Pentecostal Church to consolidate the adjoining properties along Oakhill Avenue in order to construct a church and parking lot. The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection to the adoption of City Council Bill 09-0296.
