17	§ 9-1. Definitions.
18	(A) IN GENERAL.
19	In this subtitle, the following terms have the meanings indicated.
20	(B) AGENCY.
21	"AGENCY" MEANS ANY DEPARTMENT, BOARD, COMMISSION, COUNCIL, AUTHORITY,
22	COMMITTEE, OFFICE, OR OTHER UNIT OF CITY GOVERNMENT.

17	The head of the Office is the Director of Overtime Reporting.
18	(B) APPOINTMENT.
19 20	The Director is appointed by the Comptroller, subject to conformation by the City Council.

23 24	(1) SERVES FOR A TERM CONCURRENT WITH THE COMPTROLLER'S TERM OF OFFICE; AND
25	(2) MAY BE DISCHARGED IF:
26 27	(I) PROOF OF INEFFICIENCY, NEGLECT OF DUTY, OR MISCONDUCT IN OFFICE IS PRESENTED TO THE COMPTROLLER; AND
28 29	(II) THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION SUBSTANTIATES THESE CHARGES AFTER A FULL HEARING.

2 3	The Director is entitled to compensation as provided in the Ordinance of Estimates.
4	§ 9-7. Staff; supplies; agency assistance.
5	(A) STAFF.
6 7	THE DIRECTOR MAY EMPLOY A STAFF AND MAY CONTRACT FOR CONSULTANTS AND OTHER EXPERTS AS PROVIDED IN THE ORDINANCE OF ESTIMATES.
8	(B) SUPPLIES.
9	THE DIRECTOR MAY ACQUIRE SUPPLIES AS PROVIDED IN THE ORDINANCE OF ESTIMATES
10	(C) AGENCIES TO ASSIST OFFICE.
11 12	At the request of the Office, every agency of the City of Baltimore shall provide reasonable assistance and information to the Office.

14	§ 9-9. Overtime reports.
15	(A) AGENCIES TO FILE.
16 17	EVERY AGENCY OF THE CITY SHALL FILE A MONTHLY OVERTIME REPORT WITH THE OFFICE.
18	(B) FORM AND CONTENTS.
19	The report must:
20	(1) BE IN THE FORM THAT THE DIRECTOR REQUIRES; AND
21	(2) CONTAIN:
22 23	(I) THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF OVERTIME COMPENSATION PAID OUT IN THE PREVIOUS MONTH;
24 25	(II) THE AMOUNT OF OVERTIME COMPENSATION PAID TO EACH INDIVIDUAL IN THE PREVIOUS MONTH; AND
26	(III) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT THE DIRECTOR REQUESTS.
27	(c) Compilation of reports.
28	THE OFFICE SHALL:
29	(1) COMPILE THE REPORTS RECEIVED FROM ALL AGENCIES; AND

1 2	(2) ON REQUEST, PROVIDE THE INFORMATION DERIVED FROM THESE REPORTS AND COMPILATIONS TO THE COMPTROLLER, MAYOR, OR ANY CITY COUNCIL MEMBER.
3	§ 9-10. Rules and regulations.
4	(A) DIRECTOR MAY ADOPT.
5	THE DIRECTOR MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBTITLE.
6	(B) FILING WITH LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE.
7 8	A copy of all rules and regulations must be filed with the Department of Legislative Reference before they take effect.
9 10 11	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.
12 13	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30 th day after the date it is enacted.
