14	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Parking Fines Increase
15	in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required
16	to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.
17	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
18	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated.
19	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
20	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated or is for a new program that could
21	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
22	On June 21, 2010, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
23	Council.
24	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
25	\$78,000 shall be made available to the Commission on Aging & Retirement Education –
26	Program 723 (Advocacy & Supportive Care) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating
27	Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2011, to provide funding for additional operating expenses. The
28	source of revenue for this appropriation is from the Parking Fines Increase in excess of the

- amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
