City Council bill 13-0254 has been introduced for the purpose of providing a General Fund appropriation transfer of \$1,470,000 from various City agencies to Educational Grants, States Attorney, Housing, and Health. This funding will provide for the following items: Family League after-school programming (\$1.1 million), two Assistant State's Attorney positions (\$160k), a commercial Code Enforcement inspector (\$65k), addition grant funding for BARCS (\$45k), a grant to Edmondson Village Healthy Neighborhoods (\$50k), and additional funding for Operation Safe Streets in Cherry Hill (\$50k).

As part of the Fiscal 2014 budget process, the Mayor and City Council worked together to find additional funding for after-school programs and other shared priorities. This legislation follows through on that agreement to fund these important programs.

The Department of Finance supports this legislation.
