# **Major Issues Discussed**

- 1. Councilmember Stokes gave opening remarks on the history of East Baltimore Development, Inc. (EBDI) and some of their issues.
- 2. Chairman Costello went over the agency reports with agency representatives for the bill.
- 3. EBDI gave a presentation.
- 4. Chairman Costello asked about the current By-laws and specific board members, so EBDI walked through the current board.
- 5. Councilman Stokes asked the CEO why the board was decreased, including who made the decision and why the community representative was cut. It was noted that in June 2024, the board voted to reduce to increase efficiency.
- 6. Ty'lor Schnella clarified that Calvin Young, EBDI's Chair of Board, is affiliated with the City government to Councilwoman Ramos.
- 7. Chairman Costello asked who Mr. Young reports to, which will be followed up on.
- 8. Councilman Stokes noted he received the requested information from EBDI the day of the hearing, and noted that EBDI is not transparent. The Councilman requested names of contractors, bank statements, etc.
- 9. EBDI noted that this information was provided and included in the audit presentation. They noted the organization is not in control of the audit, and it was just completed in March.
- 10. Councilman Schleifer asked about EBDI's budget and how much came from the City, \$400k.
- 11. Councilman Schleifer and EBDI discussed the organization's role in development, and how many units have been created in the past 22 years. EBDI noted that maybe 700 units have been created, which includes a mix of apartments and houses.
- 12. Councilwoman Ramos and EBDI discussed tracking residents who are forced to leave due to development, requirements for developers to allow residents to return, and development delays.
- 13. Councilman Glover and EBDI discussed Bmore Safe Haven.
- 14. Councilman Stokes and EBDI discussed the Board reduction and lack of transparency.
- 15. Councilman Schleifer and Mr.Schnella discussed why the Board members of EBDI are personnel matters, although the City Council confirms Board members of other quasi-government agencies.
- 16. Various members of the public signed in to testify.
- 17. Councilman Stokes gave closing remarks, and noted that it would like to reconvene this hearing with the Chair of the Board.
- 18. Hearing recessed.
