A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Sale of Property – 1511 Ashburton Street**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public  
4 or private sale, all its interest in certain property known as 1511 Ashburton Street (Block  
5 2408, Lot 066) and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective  
6 date.

12 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That, in  
13 accordance with Article II, § 15(c) of the City Charter, the Commissioner of Housing and  
14 Community Development may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor  
15 and City Council of Baltimore in the property known as 1511 Ashburton Street (Block 2408, Lot  
16 066), and more particularly described as follows:

17 The subject property includes the former Lillian M. Jackson school building,  
18 which is a vacant building in the Northwest Community Action area, and it  
19 became part of the Department of Housing and Community Development's  
20 inventory via the Baltimore City Public School System surplus,

21 containing 5.083 acres more or less, this property being no longer needed for public use.

22 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance  
23 unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.

24 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is  
25 enacted.
