Major Issues Discussed

- 1. Chairwoman McCray informed the attendees and/or audience that there were eleven (11) bills on today's Agenda and read out loud all of the bill numbers and titles.
- 2. Chairwoman McCray went over the agency reports with the representatives from the Law and Finance Departments.
- 3. The representatives from the Finance Department talked about and/or explained the proposed amendments for Council bills 25-0024, 0026, 0027, 0029, 0030, 0031 and 0032 and stated all eleven bills are "final fiscal year 2025 closeout actions".

 - Other Questions

 - During a given fiscal year how and when does the Finance Department know we (the city) will have adequate funding/revenue to close the budget?
 - Answer: It is an on-going process; data is reviewed on a monthly basis
 - Talked about the importance of holding agencies "accountable," especially when and if extreme mistakes (errors) occur
 - When agencies/employees make extreme errors how are they handled, or the issues addressed? Talk about this!
 - Overtime Costs
 - Explain what is driving the overtime costs for the Fire and Police Departments
 - Fire Department/Emergency Medical Services (EMS)
 - What tools are in place to bring costs down?
 - Concern: The amount of time it takes to train new employees and/or staff
 - o Is there anything that can be done to reduce the time needed to train the EMS employees?
 - Apprenticeship Program in schools should be used in this area
 - Sheriff's Office
 - The Sheriff's Office is one of these agencies to receive an Appropriation Transfer.
 - I believe they are experiencing some internal control issues this is of concern
