Introduction

For the purpose of condemning and closing subterranean portions of certain streets and alleys bounded by Westwood Avenue, North Mount Street, Presstman Street, and Appleton Street, as shown on a plat numbered 316-C-4A, Sheets 1 through 5, dated September 26, 2023, prepared by Whitman, Requardt and Associates, LLP, and filed in the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

DOT Analysis

The legislation will allow the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to close the subterranean rights-of-way. This will facilitate the transfer of these rights-of-way from the City to Amtrak, which will allow for their use in the Frederick Douglass Tunnel Program. This bill is part of a series of bills that close and transfer the right-of-way to be used by the proposed tunnel, which will allow Amtrak to operate the tunnel in perpetuity.
