I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 16-0720 City Streets – Opening – Portion of a 12-Foot Alley for the purpose of condemning and opening a portion of a 12-foot alley, extending from another 12-foot alley Northeastly 52 feet, more or less, to the southernmost extremity of Block 3563A, Lot 42B, as shown on Plat 128-A-35A in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

There are two companion bills 16-0721 – City Streets – Closing – Portion of a 12-Foot Alley and 16-0722 – Sale of Property – Former Bed of a Portion of a 12-Foot Alley.

As written 16-0720 will open a portion of a 12-foot alley that is not suitable for vehicle passage and is an unusable for general public use but does contain utilities.

DOT supports this bill and respectfully requests a favorable report.
