I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 15-0484, which repeals the requirement that gas stations provide use of air pumps free of charge to the public.

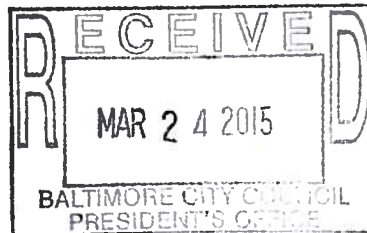

DOT has reviewed the Law Department's comments and concurs that clarity would be beneficial regarding whether the intent is to eliminate the requirement to provide air pump use altogether, or to eliminate the requirement that access to the air pumps be provided free of charge. However, DOT takes no position on the provision of air to consumers, regardless.
