13	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
14	permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a nonprofit home and
15	transitional housing facility for the care and custody of homeless persons on the property known
16	as 1801, 1803, 1805, 1807, and 1809-1825 Falls Road, as outlined in red on the plat
17	accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 6-609(1) and
18	14-102, subject to the condition that the <u>following conditions:</u>
19	1. The maximum number of resident clients is 85.
20	2. 24-hour supervision must be provided.
21	3. The nonprofit home and transitional housing facility for the care and custody of
22	homeless persons complies must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local
23	licensing and certification requirements.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and the Zoning Administrator.
