AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

**Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation –
Department of Housing and Community Development – \$459,169**

FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation in the amount of \$459,169 to the Department of Housing and Community Development – Service 738 (Weatherization Services), to provide funding for professional services and in-service training for weatherization and energy efficiency services for low-income households; and providing for a special effective date.

Recitals

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2026.

That grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2026 was formulated.

On April 15, 2026, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City Council.

1 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That
2 \$459,169 shall be made available to the Department of Housing and Community
3 Development – Service 738 (Weatherization Services) as a Supplementary State Fund Operating
4 Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2026, to provide funding for professional services and in-service
5 training for weatherization and energy efficiency services for low-income households. The
6 source of revenue for this appropriation is the grant from the Maryland Department of Housing
7 and Community Development in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the
8 Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year
9 2026.

10 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
11 enacted.


