FOR the purpose of designating the Bookbindery, 3110 Elm Avenue (Block 3504B, Lot 006), as an historical landmark: exterior.

BY adding  
Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation  
Sections 18A-8  
Baltimore City Code  
(Edition 2000)

**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

**Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation**

**Subtitle 18A. Landmark List: Exteriors – 2020s**

**§ 18A-8. ~~3110 ELM AVENUE. THE BOOKBINDERY.~~**

THE BOOKBINDERY, 3110 ELM AVENUE (BLOCK 3504B, LOT 006).

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted.
