The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 13-0288, which was introduced for the purpose of designating Public School No. 103, Henry Highland Garnet School, located at 1315 Division Street, as a historical landmark.

City Council Bill 13-0288, if approved, would support the preservation of a significant Baltimore City Landmark that played a key role in the education of thousands of children in West Baltimore, including Thurgood Marshall, the first African American Justice on the Supreme Court of the United States.
