10 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the
11 bridge located between the 1200-1300 blocks of Fort Avenue is named the Karen J. Johns
12 Memorial Bridge.

13 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
14 after the date it is enacted.
